

# 2024 Wine Tasting Results

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
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## Summary

Fellow wine enthusiasts, the moment you have been waiting for is here. Your tasting results are in!


### Did the cost of the wine matter?



In this figure the grey stars are everyone's ratings, the black dots are the average rating, and the red line is the regression slope. Overall, the group prefers cheaper wines: adding \$20 to the cost of the wine resulted in us collectively liking it 1.5 rating points less.


This negative trend was consistent across most drinkers. Our most sophisticated drinker of the evening was Tess, for whom adding \$20 to the cost of the wine would have raised her rating by 1.2 points. Our cheapest drunk was Adam, for whom adding \$20 to the cost of the wine would have lowered his rating by 5 points.

Did the order the wine was served matter?




The order in which the wines were drunk did not have an impact on the average ratings. Our lightweight of the evening was Faye, who added on average 0.25 points to her rating with each additional wine drunk – an increase of 3 rating points over the course of the evening.

## Did people prefer red or white wines?



Overall, we liked red wines slightly more than white wines (see the higher median line). However, this varied quite a bit by drinker, with Chanda and Christina exclusively liking red wines and Tess exclusively liking white wines. Adam, Braanavan, Maciek and Sam showed a preference for red wines, while Faye showed a preference for white wines.

## What varieties did people prefer?




Merlots and Cabernet Sauvignons came in as the top-rated varieties of wine, with Pinot Noirs as the least popular.

## What wines did people prefer?

Raven Conspiracy was the top rated wine, followed by Copper Moon. The lowest rated wine was the Louis Latour Pinot Noir.


These boxplots show the medians and distributions of the ratings.



## How does this compare to last time?

Ladies and gentlemen, you are in for a statistical treat. We ran a wine tasting almost exactly four years ago, and 7 of the wines in this tasting are the same as last time: Sawmill Creek Merlot, Naked Grape Chardonnay, Jackson Triggs Sauvignon Blanc, Copper Moon Cabernet Sauvignon, Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc, and Louis Latour Bourgogne Chardonnay (W) and Pinot Noir (R). We also had 7 tasters that were present at both events: Adam, Alice, Faye, Maciek, Sam, Steve, and Tess. Check out their individual pages to find out if their wine tastes have matured over the last 4 years.

Here is how the average ratings changed between the two wine tastings (black dashed line indicates average for all wines):



Overall, the Sawmill Creek Merlot, Naked Grape Chardonnay, and Louis Latour Bourgogne Chardonnay held fairly consistent average ratings over the past 4 years. As a group, we liked the Copper Moon Cabernet Sauvignon and the Jackson Triggs Sauvignon Blanc more this time than last time. The Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc was a crowd favourite in 2020 (and was the highest ranked white wine), but fell from grace in the 2024 tasting. The Louis Latour Bourgogne Pinot Noir was the overall lowest ranked wine in both tastings, but we liked it even less this time than we did last time.

Without further ado, let me introduce the wines, in the order they were drunk, so that you can evaluate for yourself whether the quality of the commentary changed with more drinks...


## (1) Naked Grape Chardonnay

- Is this naked grape? sweet wine


## (2) Sawmill Creek Merlot


### (3) Louis Latour Bourgogne (R) Pinot Noir




# Individual Wine Preferences

## Adam


Adam's ratings are primarily influenced by the cost of the wine: for every additional dollar a wine cost, he liked it a quarter-rating less. This makes him our cheapest drunk of the evening. Adam had a slight preference for red wines over white wines, but the only important feature he's looking for in a wine is that it is cheap. All wines over \$20 were his lowest rated wines.



Effect of Cost on Adam's Ratings



## Alice


Similar to four years ago, the main determinant of whether Alice likes a wine is how cheap it is. For every additional dollar spent on a bottle of wine, Alice likes it 0.17 rating points less (compared with 0.14 last time). Alice has a love-hate relationship with red wines, with all red wines receiving scores of either 8 or above, or 3 or below.



Effect of Cost on Alice's Ratings



## Branaavan



Effect of Order on Branaavan's Ratings




## Chanda


Chanda has a strong preference for red wines, with her rating for every red wine exceeding her rating for every white wine. She really liked the Pinot Noir that was the lowest ranked wine overall by the group, and was the only person who rated it at or above an 8. Chanda has some divergent tastes from the rest of the group, but despite really liking the most expensive wine, cost did not really factor into her ratings overall.




## Christina



Effect of Order on Christina's Ratings




## Faye


Last time, Faye had a preference for more expensive wines. This time, she has a preference for cheaper wines. But price isn't the most important feature: for every wine Faye had, her ratings went up by a quarter-point on average, making her the lightweight of the evening. Faye has a slight preference for white wines.



Effect of Cost on Faye's Ratings




Maciek has a slight preference for red wines. For every additional dollar a wine cost, he rated it 0.14 points lower.



Effect of Cost on Maciek's Ratings




## Marissa

The main thing I learned about Marissa during this wine tasting is that she is willing to wildly overpay for wines. Marissa doesn't have a preference for reds vs whites, but she does prefer cheaper wine: for every additional dollar a wine cost, she rated it 0.16 points lower. She also rated wines 0.13 points higher with every additional wine she drank.





Effect of Order on Mateo's Ratings




Sam prefers red wines to white wines. To be more specific, Sam likes Cabernet Sauvignons. But cost also matters: for every additional dollar a wine costs, Sam likes it 0.13 points less.



Effect of Cost on Sam's Ratings




Steve has no preference between reds and whites, but he does like wines 0.13 rating points more on average with every additional wine that he drinks.



Effect of Cost on Steve's Ratings



## Tess


Tess likes white wines and does not like red wines. Tess did not score any white wines below an 8, or any red wines above a 6. This is the single factor determining Tess' wine preferences. Technically, and much to my surprise, Tess was the snobbiest wine drinker at the tasting. Every additional dollar spent on a wine increased her ratings by 0.06. Now, 0.06 is basically zero, but is also not in the negatives like almost everybody else.



Effect of Cost on Tess' Ratings





Effect of Cost on Trevor's Ratings





## Some Final Questions

### How much would you pay for this wine?

Participants were asked how much they would pay for each bottle of wine. Broadly, you said that you would pay on average \$19.14 per bottle of wine, and this was unrelated to the actual cost of the wine. The green dashed line shows where guessed cost equals actual cost, showing that some of you (mostly Marissa) would wildly overpay for some of the cheaper wines, while none of you would pay full price for the expensive wines.



### Who was most accurate at guessing the value of the wines?


Here is the average absolute difference between how much the tasters would pay for the wine and the actual cost of the wine. Branaavan was the most accurate, estimating that he would pay on average \$6.35 from the true cost. Marissa was willing to pay an average of \$18.46 from the true cost of the wine.

## Who was the best at guessing wine varieties?

Participants were prompted to guess what wine variety they were drinking. Let's see how you did.

Here is how often each participant guessed the correct variety of wine. Faye was the best wine variety guesser, with 8/12 varieties guessed correctly!



## Who should be wine drinking buddies?

The figure below shows who have more similar tastes in wine (more red) and less similar tastes in wine (more blue). For example, Marissa and Alice had the most similar tastes in wine of everyone at the party (0.74 correlation), while Tess and Christina had the least similar tastes (-0.85 correlation).
